BioAg's mother source is estimated to be 45 million years old. Unwinding this ancient material using high heat denatures and reduces the efficacy of the end product. Why buy something that is now not as effective? At BioAg we do not take manufacturing shortcuts. Instead, using state of the art machinery and ingenuity we have designed a dry to dry conversion method for creating our dry soluble humic acid, without adding heat. Unlike raw humic substances, our product is concentrated, easy to apply, easy to ship and readily available for today's crops. Only pounds are needed instead of tons! In it's dry form, HumiSolve is stable indefinitely (liquid humic acids degrade).

Location, Location, Location

Humic substances vary greatly in source, concentration and quality. The best sources are formed in the presence of fresh water where large leafed plants (cycads, euphorbia etc.) grew during the cretaceous period. Most deposits around the world, including Leonardite, were formed in salt water where grasses (sedge and reeds etc.) grew during the older carboniferous period. This older material is more closely related to coal and oxidized slack lignite and very low in the fulvic fraction (biostimulating fraction). There are few known deposits that have both desirable attributes: fresh water formation and protection from weathering and oxidation. There is only one source in the US. BioAg uses premium New Mexico humic substances, formed in fresh water, that have been encapsulated with 20+ feet of sandstone. They are high in both fulvic and humic. Even in New Mexico, mines only several miles apart can have different qualities. Our material comes from the basin, not from the rim of the formation where it has cracked open and weathered. This would be like leaving your compost out in the rain for millions of years. Because of the large degree of differences in source materials it's important to work with specialists who understand what to look for.
